

THE REGIONAL WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY: 2024-01-10 ISSUED AT 04:50 SAST BY THE SOUTH AFRICAN WEATHER SERVICE.
THIS FORECAST WILL BE UPDATED AT 16:00 SAST.

SEVERE WEATHER ALERTS:

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IMPACT-BASED WARNINGS:

- A. Yellow level 4 warning: Severe thunderstorms are expected over the southern parts of North West Province and the north-central parts of the Free State. These storms are expected to produce heavy downpours, strong winds, hail and excessive lightning that may result in flooding of roads, settlements and low-lying areas resulting in closure of some bridges and roads, danger to life (fast flowing streams/deep water) danger to informal/formal houses or structures over populated areas (urban or rural villages), and structural damages (homes, car port(etc)).
- B. Yellow level 2 warning: Severe thunderstorms are expected over the northern parts of the North West Province (except for the north-east), Free State, the extreme north-east of the Northern Cape, the south-eastern parts of Mpumalanga and the northern parts of KwaZulu-Natal. These storms are expected to produce heavy downpours, strong winds, hail and excessive lightning that may result in localised flooding of susceptible roads, low-lying areas and bridges, localised damage to informal houses(roofs) over an open area, and localised structural damage (homes, car port,etc.),
- C. Yellow Level 2 warning: Disruptive rainfall resulting in localised flooding of susceptible formal/informal settlements, low-lying roads and bridges, as well as short term disruptions to municipal services, is expected in places over the eastern half of the Eastern Cape as well as in the extreme southern parts of KwaZulu-Natal..

ADVISORIES:

1. GAUTENG:

Cloudy and warm with scattered showers and thundershowers but isolated in the north.

The expected UVB sunburn index: Extreme

2. MPUMALANGA:

Partly cloudy and cool to warm with isolated to scattered showers and thundershowers, except in the Lowveld.

3. LIMPOPO:

Partly cloudy and warm to hot with isolated showers and thundershowers in the extreme south.

4. NORTH-WEST PROVINCE:

Cloudy and warm with scattered to widespread showers and thundershowers, but isolated in the north-east.

5. FREE STATE:

Cloudy and cool to warm, with widespread showers and thundershowers.

6. NORTHERN CAPE:

Cloudy along the coast in the morning becoming fine, otherwise partly cloudy and warm to hot but very hot in places in the north. It will become cloudy in the east by the afternoon, with isolated to scattered showers and thundershowers.

The wind along the coast will be light to moderate southerly to south-westerly reaching fresh at times.

7. WESTERN CAPE:

Fine in the west where it will be hot to very hot, otherwise partly cloudy and cool to warm but cloudy with isolated rain and showers along the south coast. The wind along the coast will be fresh to strong south-easterly.

The expected UVB sunburn index: Extreme

8. WESTERN HALF OF THE EASTERN CAPE:

Cloudy and cool to warm with isolated showers and thundershowers but scattered in the east.

The wind along the coast will be light to moderate easterly.

9. EASTERN HALF OF THE EASTERN CAPE:

Cloudy and warm with widespread showers and thundershowers.

The wind along the coast will be light to moderate easterly.

10. KWAZULU-NATAL:



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Morning fog over the interior , otherwise partly cloudy and warm but hot in places in the north-east. Isolated to scattered showers and thundershowers are expected, but widespread in the south-west.

The wind along the coast will be moderate to fresh easterly to north-easterly.
