Mostly settled weather for the Local Government Elections

On Monday, 1 November 2021, South Africans are going to the polls to vote in the Local Government elections. Overall, weather conditions are expected to be mostly sunny, with warm to hot temperatures. In the western parts, a cold front will result in cooler temperatures with wet and windy conditions.

The provincial weather forecast break down is given below:

GAUTENG: Partly cloudy and warm.

<u>MPUMALANGA:</u> Partly cloudy and warm but hot in the lowveld

LIMPOPO: Fine and warm to hot.

NORTH-WEST PROVINCE: Fine and warm

FREE STATE: Fine and warm.

NORTHERN CAPE:

Cloudy and cool in the west with rain showers, otherwise partly cloudy, windy and warm.

WESTERN CAPE:

Cloudy and cool in the west with showers along the coast, otherwise partly cloudy, windy and warm.

EASTERN CAPE:

Partly cloudy and warm to hot, becoming cooler with rain showers along the south coast and adjacent interior from evening. It will become windy from midday.

KWAZULU-NATAL:

Fine and warm to hot.
