Tropical Storm Gombe heading to Mozambique Channel




Figure 1: Day Natural Colour RGB satellite image showing current location of Gombe over northern Madagascar on 8 March 2022 at 09h00 SAST. Image © Eumetsat

Tropical Storm Gombe has just made landfall over northern Madagascar (Figure 1) and is expected to move into the Mozambique Channel tomorrow, 9 March 2022.




Figure 2: The latest forecast track for Gombe, as issued by Regional Specialized Meteorological centre (RSMC) La Reunion at 08h00 SAST on 8 March 2022. Source: MeteoFrance

Once in the Channel, Gombe is expected to strengthen as a result of the warm sea surface temperatures (SST) combined with moisture from the ocean. Gombe is forecasted to reach tropical cyclone intensity by Friday, 11 March 2022, when it is projected to briefly make landfall over northern Mozambique (Figure 2). This landfall will be short lived, as currently Gombe is once again expected to enter the Mozambique Channel by Sunday (13 March 2022).
