

THE REGIONAL WEATHER FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: 2024-02-27
ISSUED AT 16:00 SAST BY THE SOUTH AFRICAN WEATHER SERVICE.
THIS FORECAST WILL BE UPDATED AT 05:00 SAST.

SEVERE WEATHER ALERTS:

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IMPACT-BASED WARNINGS:

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1. A yellow level 2 warning for damaging winds leading to difficulty in navigation at sea is expected between Cape Columbine and Cape Agulhas.

FIRE DANGER WARNINGS:

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Extremely high fire danger conditions are expected over the central parts of Northern Cape and the Kamiesberg and Hantam municipalities, over the West Coast and the Central Karoo municipalities (Western Cape).

ADVISORIES:

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Extremely hot and uncomfortable conditions are expected in places over the West Coast (Western Cape), Kamiesberg (Northern Cape) municipalities on Tuesday and Wednesday.

1. GAUTENG:

Cloudy and cool with isolated showers and thundershowers, but warm in the north.

The expected UVB sunburn index: High

2. MPUMALANGA:

Cloudy and cool. Drizzle can be expected along the escarpment.

3. LIMPOPO:

Cloudy and cool to warm with morning drizzle along the escarpment.

4. NORTH-WEST PROVINCE:

Fine in the west at first, otherwise partly cloudy and hot to very hot, with isolated showers and thundershowers in the east.



5. FREE STATE:

Cloudy with morning fog patches in the east at first, otherwise fine and warm to hot, becoming partly cloudy with isolated showers and thundershowers in the east.

6. NORTHERN CAPE:

Fine and hot to very hot but extremely hot over the southwest. It will be warm over the northern coastline.

The wind along the coast will be light and variable in the morning, otherwise fresh to strong southerly. It will remain light and variable north of Port Nolloth.

7. WESTERN CAPE:

Partly cloudy in the extreme north-east in the morning, otherwise fine and hot to very hot but extremely hot over most parts of the West Coast district. It will be warm along the south-west and south coast.

The wind along the coast will be strong to gale south-easterly along the south-west coast and fresh to strong easterly to north-easterly along the south coast.

The expected UVB sunburn index: Extreme

8. WESTERN HALF OF THE EASTERN CAPE:

Cloudy in places at first, otherwise fine and warm but cool along the coast.

The wind along the coast will be light and variable, becoming moderate to fresh easterly by afternoon.

9. EASTERN HALF OF THE EASTERN CAPE:

Cloudy and cool to warm with isolated showers and rain along the wild coast, becoming fine over the northern and western parts by afternoon.

The wind along the coast will be light westerly in the morning, otherwise light south-easterly.



10. KWAZULU-NATAL:

Morning fog over the interior, otherwise cloudy and cool with isolated showers and rain. The wind along the coast will be moderate southerly to south-westerly, becoming south-easterly in the extreme south by evening.

The expected UVB sunburn index: Moderate

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
